- 249:** 1 unit. Additional work in connection with upper division courses. Students attend lectures and do all written work in the main course, and also read assignments in the Scandinavian language and write a paper. May be repeated.
- 298:** 2-12 units. May not substitute for available seminars. Tutorial designed to explore a restricted field involving the writing of a report. May be repeated for letter grade or S/U credit.
- 299:** 2-12 units. Post advancement to candidacy dissertation research and writing. May be repeated. (S/U only).
- 601:** 1-8 units. Individual study with a faculty adviser during the semester of the Master's Examination. (S/U only).
- 602:** 1-8 units. Individual study with a faculty adviser during the semester of the Ph.D. Qualifying Examination. (S/U only).

UNITS IN CONJUNCTION WITH TEACHING:

- 300A:** 3 units. Methods of Teaching Scandinavian Languages, Required pedagogy in current theory and practice of foreign language teaching in connection with Danish, Finnish, Norwegian, and Swedish. May be repeated. (S/U only).
- 300B:** 1 unit. Teaching Practicum, Repeat each semester of GSI employment following the completion of 300A or the equivalent Reading and Composition pedagogy course. (S/U only).
